- Maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the local and wider community.

All clothing should be clearly labelled.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. The wearing of school uniforms is compulsory for all students except where exemption is given by the Principal.

2. The acceptable school uniform should consist of a combination of items from the designated uniform list. A note from parents should be sent to school on any day if the school uniform cannot be worn.
3. Students participating in inter-school sport and excursions will wear the appropriate uniform.
4. Sports uniforms will be worn only on sports days, PE lesson day and/or when representing our school in sporting events.
5. Uniforms are available from Primary School Wear, Sunbury.
6. Arrangements can be made to supply uniforms via State Schools Relief for families experiencing economic hardship.
7. A special jacket for Grade 6 students will be available for purchase each year.
8. Guidelines relating to out of uniform days will be published in the newsletter prior to the event.
9. Wearing a hat (as prescribed in the uniforms list) is compulsory for all outdoor activities from September to April each year.
10. Hair should be neat and well-groomed at all times. Hair should remain a natural colour. It is recommended that hair which is longer than shoulder length must be tied back at all times in line with our head lice management procedures.
11. Fashion jewellery is a health hazard during any physical activity and should not be worn to school. Stud earrings in pierced ears are an exception.
12. Make up and coloured nail polish are not to be worn except for approved school activities.
13. Closed shoes such as runners and black leather school shoes must be worn to school. Thongs and open toed sandals are not to be worn. Socks must be worn at all times.
14. Teachers will use their discretion to speak with students when incorrect school uniform is worn.
15. The monitoring of the school uniform policy should be the responsibility of school council with the day to day decisions to be at the discretion of the Principal.
16. On prescribed casual clothes days, students must wear clothing that is sunsmart. No singlet tops or shoulder less tops should be worn.

Enforcement of the Uniform policy is the responsibility of the Principal and supported by the staff.
